As we have taken precautions to assure the safety of our patients and staff, we have restricted visitors within the organization and requested that Team B staff members shelter in place until those departmental services are reopened and required. These initiatives are temporary, as it takes us all to make TGMC run, but these are unprecedented times as we all work through the COVID crisis.

Recently, TGMC has received an outpouring of support from our community. Local restaurants have generously donated food keeping our employees well fed during long shifts. Community members donated thoughtful care packages providing comfort to staff while away from their homes. Healthy residents donated blood, which goes directly to patients in our hospital.

While TGMC currently has a supply of N-95 masks, surgical masks, gowns, face shields, and soap for our staff to use, and to protect our patients, future orders have proven difficult to fill in the usual timely manner. The large donation of masks, hand-made by many, have provided general protection for our non-clinical areas and team members.
