The Cancer Center is nationally accredited with commendation and recognized for excellence in cancer care by the American College of Surgeons Commission on Cancer and the National Quality Oncology Practice Initiative (QOPI®) Certification Program, an affiliate of the prestigious American Society of Clinical Oncology (A.S.C.O.).

We are at the forefront of the diagnosis and treatment of coronary and peripheral artery disease performing over 3,250 cardiac procedures every year.

Our Cardiology Partnership with world-renowned Cardiovascular Institute of the South (CIS) for more than 37 years provides cardiovascular care in our community.

Comprehensive treatments include balloon angioplasty, atherectomy, and stent placement.



Terrebonne General is proud to be the only facility in the region offering more than 40 innovative cardiac clinical research trials and advanced electrophysiology to treat an irregular heartbeat and the Structural Heart program. Structural Heart procedures are performed in Terrebonne General's Hybrid Operating Room (OR). This advanced procedural space combines a traditional operating room with an image guided interventional suite allowing for highly complex, advanced surgical procedures. Procedures include groundbreaking clinical trials, percutaneous heart valve replacement, carotid artery stenting, and lower extremity revascularization.

The Diagnostic and Special Imaging Department is robust, performing over 140,000 exams per year and offering services including: HD Cat Scans, 3T and 1.5T HD MRIs, Nuclear Medicine, Pet



CT, Digital Mammography, Stereotactic Breast Biopsy, Breast Specific Gamma Imaging, Bone Densitometry, Ultrasound, Neurology and Digital X-Ray. We are the only facility in the state to use the GE Revolution Frontier Gen 2 CT Scanner providing medical experts with the clearest, most accurate images available on the market.

Our Hyperbaric and Wound Healing Center treats all wounds, especially non-healing wounds with advanced therapies to accelerate the healing process.

To further healthcare education and advancement in our community, Terrebonne General invested substantially to expand the Fletcher Technical Community College nursing and allied health programs to train our community's next generation of healthcare professionals.
