Terrebonne General Medical Center provides financial assistance for:

- Emergency and medically necessary care,
- To patients who are residents of Louisiana,
- And who are unable to pay.

Financial assistance applies to your portion of the bill only, for example, your deductible or co-payment.

Eligibility

Financial assistance is based on your family income and the current Federal Poverty Level. The current Federal Poverty Level can be found at <https://aspe.hhs.gov/poverty-guidelines>.

Financial Assistance is offered as follows:

- If your family income is 150% or less of the Federal Poverty Level, you may receive a 100% discount.
- If your family income is more than 150% but less than 300% of the Federal Poverty Level, you may be eligible to receive discounted rates based on a sliding scale (Sliding scale detailed can be found in the Financial Assistance Policy under Attachment A).
- If your family income is more than 300% of the Federal Poverty Level, you may be eligible to receive discounted rates based on a case-by-case basis based on your specific circumstances, such as catastrophic illness or medical indigence, at the discretion of TGMC.

Patient Billing Rights

Patients who receive financial assistance may not be charged more for the same services generally billed to insured patients.
